Eligible Players:

U19: players who are U19 years of age through the year 2024 (i.e. born on 2006 or younger) To participate in a Continental Pan American Championships, the player must hold a passport of a country whose territory the Member Association has jurisdiction over. **BPAC** requires player's passports to confirm their age and nationality.

According to the BPAC Regulations **Associated Members** can enter players to a Continental Events as long as their BWF **BWF ID** is registered under the name of the Associated Member and has been born in the Associated Member Territory.

Players passports will be required at the end of the Team Managers Meeting

Entry Fee:

The member association that enters a player into a circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player.

Transportation:

Badminton Mexico (FEMEBA) will provide mandatory transportation from the local airport (Aeropuerto Internacional de Aguascalientes, Lic. Jesus Teran Peredo - AGU) to the official hotels, and daily to tournament venue, for players, team members and entourage which has been registered at the official hotel through the Organizing Committee (Use the online format on Pan Am Website).

Any extra SHUTTLE from Airport to Hotel or reverse will cause a charge of US\$35.00 per person.



Uniforms:

According **BPAC** regulations, for all tournaments the player's name and country name on the back of the shirt is mandatory. (BWF GCR, referencing player's clothing, designs advertising and lettering).

Take note that the name of the player on the back of the shirt must comply with the name registered on BWF – player's data base.

Anti - Doping:

Anti-doping will be conducted in accordance with BWF and WADA regulations. Please consult the BWF website for further information, and to view the current WADA Prohibited List. Please note that athletes must complete a TUE application process to apply for authorization to take medications which fall under the Prohibited List – before they take medication.

Doping control

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament. To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match (es).
