		GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."	
35	Covid-19 Protocols:	• The competitions will be held with public, social distancing is mandatory. The use of a	
		mask is mandatory according to the specifications by the Ministry of Public Health and	
		Social Assistance of Guatemala. Access to the competition facility will be for PLAYERS,	
		COACHES, STAFF AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC.	
		• To enter the country it is necessary to have a vaccination card with at least 2 doses administered. Quarantine is not necessary.	
		• The assembly of the game carpets will be carried out with a distance of at least 2 meters between game courts, always seeking distance for the competitors.
